Graduation Speaker Jason Reeves



Jason Reeves grew up on a farm in western Tennessee, where he fell in love with the plant world. He received his Master's degree in Ornamental Horticulture and Landscape Design from the University of Tennessee, Knoxville. In 2002, he became a research horticulturist and curator of the University of Tennessee Gardens located

at the West Tennessee Research and Education Center in Jackson, Tennessee. Jason's colorful plant combinations and unique garden art, made by recycling everyday objects, draws several thousand people each year to the Center's annual lawn and garden show, Summer Celebration. His past experiences include work at the Opryland Conservatories in Nashville, Missouri Botanical Garden, Longwood Gardens in Pennsylvania, and in private gardens in New Zealand. When he's not bringing the grounds to life with his imaginative garden displays, he's evaluating hundreds of new and unique plants for the state's green industry; speaking at gardening symposiums or traveling the world leading gardening tours, and serving as a contributing editor to Fine Gardening magazine. He is also a landscape designer and consultant whose influence may be seen in landscapes across Tennessee in the form of distinct plant combinations and his signature garden art.

Planting Bulbs at Rippavilla

Members of the Master Gardeners of Maury County, along with some generous Spring Hill residents, collected at the Rippavilla Plantation Wednesday afternoon, February 27th, to help spruce up its garden, planting tulip, daffodil and allium flower bulbs.

The Master Gardeners of Maury County is a coalition of trained gardeners who organize gardening projects and programs, helping to bring some life to gardens the county over. In addition to the Master Gardeners, willing residents of Spring Hill also came out to help, enjoying the comfortable weather on the grounds of the historic plantation.

"I'm thrilled that we have community people here – that is exciting," said Kathie Wilson, a member of the Master Gardeners since 2015. "To be able to put things in the dirt and see them grow, there's just something thrilling about that."

Lynn Smith, who sits on the board of directors for Rippavilla, said she was "overwhelmed" with the amount of help that came out Wednesday.

"The ultimate goal is to make the gardens look as beautiful as what the house is," Smith said. "We would like for this to be some place that people can come and enjoy, enjoy the beauty of it. We would like for it to be some place that people, as they have family members come in from out of town, or friends from out of town, [that] this [would be] some place they would want to come and say, 'this is what our city has, this is our city history, and this is how beautiful this is.' That would be our goal, for people to see what we have here in this community."

Now that the flower bulbs have been planted, Smith said they should bloom in the next four to six weeks – weather permitting – and bring some much needed color to the Rippavilla gardens.
