Preparation

- We need PLANTS, LOTS of PLANTS to fill the Baker building!
- Vases and fresh cut flowers are needed for our flower arranging table
- Find any garden related items you would like to donate to sale

- Label all your pots with the name of the plant and care requirements, Sun/shade, lot of water/just a little, etc. If you don't know the name of a plant you can take a picture and post it to our facebook page asking for an ID, use a plant ID app or touch base with a gardening friend. (For Iris PLEASE INCLUDE COLOR on label If you dig just before sale you can place in boxes or in bags)
- Remember to cut out the pictures and description from plant catalogs or get them on line if your plant is not on the list below. We will laminate them at the Friday set-up on May 7th.

- Divide one or more of your plants while you are in the garden and pot them for our plant sale. Your garden will look better as will our plant sale! The sooner you can get the plants off to a good start, the happier they will look for our sale.
