We need PLANTS, LOTS of PLANTS to fill the Baker building!

This is a great opportunity for volunteer hours for members and interns! You can count your prep time at home and service hours for working Friday and Saturday with the set up and sale.

This plant sale will be here before you know it - in less than two months!

Now is the time to get going:

- Start seeds and attend the ones you have already planted
- Transplant seedlings and label them.
- Separate plants
- Dig Iris and PLEASE INCLUDE COLOR on label (If you dig just before sale you can place in boxes or in bags)
- Be sure to transplant plants in time for the roots to be established
- Clean out your garden shed
 - Find any garden related items you would like to donate to sale
 - Clean vases will also be needed
- Plan to bring cut flowers and greenery from your garden to be used in live arrangements early the morning of the sale.

Since it has been two years since our last sale and some are new to the plant sale, timelines and what to expect follow on the next page.

- Bring and pick up any pots you would like to donate for plants to be potted in
- There will be a sign-up sheet for Friday and Saturday, May 7 and 8.

Friday May 7th, eve of the sale

- Set up begins at 3 pm (tables will arrive at 2:30 pm
- Set up tables
- Cover tables
- Set up holding area
- Set up cashiers
- Place ENTRANCE, EXIT, SPACING REMINDERS as per covid requirements
- Set up and label SANITATION STATIONS
- Receive and set up plants as they arrive
- Label and price plants (This takes a while!)

Saturday May 8th, Day of the Sale

- Be at the Baker building by 7:15 am
- Bring your fresh cut flowers and clean vases
- Job assignments will be given
- Guidelines for how we are conducting the sale will be reviewed
- Sale starts at 8am

In order to comply with UT requirements for this sale: workers will need to wear masks, doors will need to remain open, there will be no food for sale on premises. MCMG will have some water bottles for the workers.
