- 1. As you dig up your perennials, PLEASE REMEMBER TO LABEL THEM. You might want to print out the names on your computer and save them for next year. Or.... write on tags. If you don't know the name, ask someone on Friday at setup.
- 2. We would appreciate it if EVERYONE WHO DROPS OFF THEIR PLANTS ON FRIDAY STAYS TO HELP US WITH PRICING THE PLANTS. FRIDAY SET-UP 4 TO 6:30.
- 3. We will try to honor your request for the job you signed up for but please be flexible as the need arises.
- 4. Last year we had requests for specific tomatoes and peppers. Please LABEL THE TYPES OF TOMATOES OR PEPPERS ETC. that you have grown so we can meet our customer's needs.
- 5. JANE ANN NEEDS LOTS OF SMALLER VASES/CONTAINERS (not just bud vases... they can be teapots, cups, other cute containers) for children to make flower arrangements for their moms. Please BRING ALL THE CUT FLOWERS YOU CAN from your garden for the flower arranging booth.

To enter your project hours:

- 1. Go to the website https://temg.tennessee.edu/ and Sign in or Register
- 2. After you log in select CEU or Project from the menu across the top OR Click on Green Report Project button.
- 3. On the next screen click on Log Project Hours. A menu will appear at the bottom of the page called User Project Reporting.
- 4. Click the arrow to reveal the list of projects and select one of the 10 projects.
- 5. THEN click on the spyglass (search icon). This will create another menu at the bottom where you can enter the hours, miles, and project date by selecting the calendar icon.
- 6. Click Submit.
- 7. You can continue entering project hours or CEU's or Logout.

I will bring a laptop to the Plant Sale. During down times at the sale you may enter your hours. I will try to help as needed.

Maury County Master Gardeners are required to complete the "Tennessee Extension Volunteer Application Form." The Interns from 2018 and 2019 and most members have completed the forms. If you are able to register then your Volunteer form was completed and the information was entered by an Extension Agent. If you are unable to register then either the form was not completed or it was not entered by an Extension Agent.
